I. INTRODUCTION

Vice-chair Graff called the meeting to order. Self-introductions were made. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

II. APPROVAL OF MAY 7, 2015 MEETING MINUTES

Mr. Berry made a motion to approve minutes. Mr. Vogt seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

III. PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD ON ACTION ITEMS

IV. MPO (METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION) ACTION ITEMS

A. Adoption of Amendment to MVRPC;s SFY2016-2019 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP

Mr. Arnold referred to a memo on page 5 of the mailout, explaining the need to a TIP Amendment. He referred to the one project table for Greene County for US68. Mr. Arnold stated that staff does recommend adoption of this TIP amendment, and referred to a resolution on page 8. Ms. Wallace made a motion for adoption. Mr. Joseph seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

V. INFORMATION ITEMS

A. Culture Works Strategic Plan

Mr. Hankins introduced Ms. Collier, President & CEO of Culture Works. He noted the importance of the arts in our region and how it contributes to economic development as well as provides appeal to others looking to relocate to our area.

Ms. Martine Collier from Culture Works provided a presentation on Culture Works 20/20, their newly developed strategic plan. Ms. Collier referred to a recent publication called "Guide to Arts & Culture in the Dayton Region". She stated that this has been a very useful resource to area realtors and employers to draw people to the area. Ms. Collier reviewed the process used for development of the plan, noting that the steering committee co-chairs were Larry Klaben, President & CEO of Morris Furniture and Deborah Lieberman, Montgomery Co. Commissioner.

Ms. Collier shared the vision of the plan as well as a list of 6 goals developed as part of the plan.

- Economic Development
- Education
- Diversity
- Resources
- Capacity Building
- Implementation

She explained how there was positive participation by focus groups who reviewed a study of funding models. The group recognized the need for alternative funding, which included examples of a cigarette tax and a district tax. Ms. Collier explained that the best method for Dayton is not yet certain, but this plan is designed as a 10 year road map to help determine specifics down the road. Ms. Collier encouraged members to review more details of the plan at <u>www.cultureconnects2020.org</u>, and contact her if anyone is interested in serving on a sub-committee.

B. 2015 Update of the Congestion Management Process

Ms. Parikh presented an overview of the Congestion Management Process Technical Report which was completed by MVRPC in May 2015. The report was produced to update the progress of the Region's congestion management strategies and integrate it into MVRPC's transportation planning processes. She mentioned that the 2015 CMP report was redesigned to include a number of new features including corridor level performance measurements, development of a regional report card, peer city comparison of congestion performance measures and development of a toolbox of congestion management strategies in accordance with performance measurement and reporting requirements of the MAP-21 legislation.

Ms. Parikh presented several examples of performance measures used by MVRPC to measure recurring and non-recurring congestion in the Region including level of service, corridor travel time reliability, mobility, safety and accessibility measures, as well as identification of congested corridors in the Region. She explained that MVRPC follows a multimodal approach to addressing congestion in the Region through completion of the Regional Bikeway Plan, Freight Movement Study, keeping track of transit routes and ridership as well as incorporating various sustainability/livability initiatives in its transportation planning process such as RIDESHARE, regional land use plan and travel demand management.

Ms. Parikh reported that MVRPC's most direct roadway congestion mitigation measures are multimodal capital transportation projects and improvements that increase capacity, safety or efficiency of the road network. These are incorporated into MVRPC's 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP). Ms. Parikh noted that the 2015 Congestion Management Process Technical Report as well as the Congestion Management Process Brochure is available in pdf format on MVRPC's website at http://www.mvrpc.org/transportation/long-range-planning-Irtp/congestion-management-process.

C. Miami Valley Bike Counting Program Assessment

Mr. Peters presented information on a new MVRPC program to begin collecting bicycle counts. He explained that it's important to begin collecting bicycling counts so that bicycle usage across the Region can be measured and tracked. Bicycle counts will help support decision making regarding prioritization of funds for new bicycle infrastructure, and MVRPC will become a one-stop repository for bicycle count information. Mr. Peters stated that the Region's trail management agencies have permanent automatic counters that collect trail counts on the bikeway. Annually, MVRPC will collaborate with those agencies to compile their data. Additionally, he explained that MVRPC has purchased two automatic counters that collect bicycle-only counts. MVRPC will temporarily install those counters on on-road bike lanes and the sections of bikeway for 7-days and conduct short-term count studies. Finally, Mr. Peters explained that MVRPC members can borrow the bicycle-only counter to perform short-term studies in their own jurisdictions. V. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Mr. Martin referred to a handout that provided his report for June. He provided an update on the 2015 TRAC solicitation process and schedule, noting the deadline to submit a TRAC application is Tuesday, June 30, 2015. Mr. Martin explained that the purpose of this process is to establish a prioritized list of projects which will be submitted as the Region's requests for TRAC funding and he provided the website address where all necessary documents for a project application are available for download. Mr. Martin reported that May was cycling month, and during all summer months there will be an increase in bicycles and pedestrians. The users of the LINK Bikeshare program are steadily increasing. He shared two Public Service announcements that MVRPC has recently produced and released promoting bicycle safety.

Mr. Martin announced that On Friday, May 22, MVRPC launched our redesigned and reorganized website featuring our new logo and colors. The updated site, available at <u>www.mvrpc.org</u> is up and running, and staff is very pleased with it. He encouraged members to visit the website and become familiar with the new look. Mr. Martin provided a staffing update, noting the hiring of several new employees as well as two summer interns. He also reported that at this morning's Executive Committee meeting, the committee approved a new 3 year contract for his position.

The report also included a list of upcoming meetings.

VIII. ADJOURNMENT

Mr. Vogt made a motion to adjourn. Mr. Haddad seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

WHEREAS, the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission is designated as the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) by the Governor acting through the Ohio Department of Transportation in cooperation with locally elected officials for Greene, Miami and Montgomery Counties including the jurisdictions of Carlisle, Franklin and Springboro in Warren County; and

WHEREAS, the SFY2016-SFY2019 Transportation Improvement Program was adopted on May 7, 2015; and

WHEREAS, MVRPC and ODOT have made numerous modifications to the programming documents for various projects resulting in the need for a SFY2016-SFY2019 TIP amendment; and

WHEREAS, the proposed amendment is consistent with the Region's long-range transportation plan; and

WHEREAS, this TIP amendment will not affect the regional air quality emission analysis of the SFY2016-SFY2019 TIP; and

WHEREAS, the MVRPC Public Participation Policy for Transportation Planning process allows for minor TIP amendments such as this to occur without separate public involvement meetings; and

WHEREAS, this amendment will result in a TIP that is in reasonable fiscal constraint

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission hereby adopts **Amendment #2** to the <u>SFY2016-SFY2019 Transportation</u> <u>Improvement Program</u> as shown on the attached TIP Tables.

Subject: CY2015 TRAC Applications Submitted within the MVRPC Region.

Solicitation for ODOT Transportation Review Advisory Council (TRAC) projects began on May 28, 2015. As of the June 30th application deadline, MVRPC received two applications, which include:

	Project	<u>Sponsor</u>	<u>\$ Requested</u>
1.	Greene US 35 Interchanges Project	ODOT D-8 / Beavercreek	<u>\$32.0 mil</u>

This project consists of the elimination of the five (5) at-grade intersections between Shakertown Road and the Xenia Bypass through the construction of new interchanges at Factory Road/Orchard Lane and Valley/Trebein Roads. The sponsor is requesting that the portion of the project that contains the Factory/Orchard section remain on Tier 2 and requesting \$6 million for R/W Acquisition. The application includes local funding toward right of way purchases. The sponsor is requesting \$26 million for the portion of the project that contains the Valley/Trebein intersection for Construction. This will allow the efficient use of remaining project funds to achieve a buildable project that encourages economic growth and addresses transportation concerns in the US 35 corridor.

2. Montgomery US 35 Improvements ODOT D-7

<u>\$29.52 mil</u>

This project will consist of major pavement rehabilitation of the existing U.S. 35 mainline and include construction of an additional lane in each direction from Livingston Avenue to the Montgomery County and Greene County Line.

MVRPC staff started reviewing these prospective projects on June 30th. Staff released the draft rankings to the project sponsors on July 29th. MVRPC staff and the project sponsors are currently working to reach a consensus on the final scores and rankings. The final project scores and rankings will be presented to the MVRPC Board of Directors on September 3rd for final review and adoption. Following the adoption of the projects, MVRPC staff and the project sponsors will prepare for the TRAC Public Hearing that will be held October 13th at ODOT Central Office.

Subject: Going Places Summary Booklet and Implementation Tools Progress Updates
