A. Zoning Amendment Requested By:

Beavercreek Township Zoning Commission.

B. Nature of the Amendment Request: To update zoning resolution text to address overgrown trees in the street right of way.

Addition:

Section 18.36 TREES PROHIBITED IN STREET RIGHT OF WAY

Planting, growing, raising, or cultivating any tree within the right of way on any Township street in is prohibited. Nothing in this section shall be deemed to require a change in plans lawfully approved by the Township prior to the effective date of this section. If a tree dies or is otherwise removed from the right of way, the property owner shall not replace that tree in compliance with this section.

D. Perspectives 2040

The amendment complies with Perspectives 2040 due to the Access Management section under Coordination Transportation and Land Use that states; "Providing access to property and moving traffic are the two major functions of roadways. In some cases, the two uses clash with one another and cause congestion and safety issues due to increased conflict points. It is the role of access management to minimize these conflicts and attempt to maintain the intended function of the roadway." Pg. 72

SUGARCREEK TOWNSHIP RESOLUTION NO. 2024.08.05.05

IN RE: Resolution to Amend Text of the Sugarcreek Township Zoning Resolution and Transmit a Copy to the Zoning Commission to Prohibit Trees in the Street Right-of-Way

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 519.12 (A)(1) prescribes the authority of the Board of Trustees, by passage of a resolution, to initiate amendments to the zoning resolution; and

WHEREAS, upon passage, the certification of a resolution by the Board of Trustees will be made to the Zoning Commission and a public hearing of the Zoning Commission will be scheduled for not less than twenty nor more than forty days from the date of the certification of such resolution; and

WHEREAS, within five days after the passage of this resolution by the Board of Trustees, the Zoning Commission will transmit a copy of it to the Greene County Regional Planning & Coordinating Commission for approval, disapproval, or suggestion; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees and staff have identified the need to prohibit trees in the street right-of-way to protect the general health and safety of residents and commuters as they provide obstruction, line-of-sight issues, damage to public infrastructure, and other safety concerns; and,

WHEREAS, it is the position of the Board of Trustees to prohibit trees in the street right-ofway and incorporate such prohibition in the Sugarcreek Township Zoning Resolution.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, this Board of Trustees does hereby adopt the following:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The following text amendment of the Zoning Resolution is initiated to Zoning Commission for approval:

Section	TREES PROHIBITED	IN STREET	RIGHT-C)F-WAY

Planting, growing, raising, or cultivating any tree within the right-of-way on any Township street is prohibited. Nothing in this section shall be deemed to require a change in plans lawfully approved by the Township prior to the effective date of this section. If a tree dies or is otherwise removed from the right-of-way, the property owner shall not replace that tree in compliance with this section.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: Upon passage of this resolution, a certified copy of it will be transmitted to the Zoning Commission who will schedule a public hearing of the Zoning Commission. Said public hearing will be scheduled for not less than twenty nor more than forty days from the date of the certification of such a resolution.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: within five days after the passage of this resolution by the Board of Trustees, the Zoning Commission will transmit a copy of it to the Greene County Regional Planning & Coordinating Commission for approval, disapproval, or suggestion.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: all formal actions of the Board of Trustees concerning and related to the adoption of this resolution are being adopted at a duly called and authorized open meeting of the Board of Trustees on the date set forth above, such meeting being duly called, pursuant to and in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
